## Capitol Corridor Rail Services: (Auburn-Sacramento-Bay Area-San Jose)

- No checked baggage service on the *Capitols*. Baggage may be checked on the *California Zephyr* or *Coast Starlight* between any two staffed stations along the route--subject to delay.

- Wheelchair Accessible (reservations for wheelchair passengers must be made 24 hours in advance)
- Deluxe reclining seat motor coaches offering dedicated connections to and from Amtrak trains. Reservations necessary on bus routes 3, 7 and 28.

## Rail Transit Connections

**Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART)** operates frequent rail transit service on five lines serving 39 stations in Alameda, San Francisco, Contra Costa and San Mateo Counties. Trains operate from 4:00am to Midnight Weekdays, 6:00am to Midnight Saturdays and 8:00am to Midnight Sundays. The BART Richmond Station is adjacent to the Amtrak Richmond Station. The BART Embarcadero Station is about 2 blocks from the Amtrak Ticket Office and Bus Stop at the Ferry Building.

**San Francisco Municipal Railway (Muni)** operates frequent transit service throughout San Francisco.

The N-Judah train connects the Embarcadero Station with the Caltrain Depot at 4th and King Streets, via the Embarcadero. The J, K, L, M and N lines run underground along Market, then above ground to different parts of the city. Muni also has an extensive network of surface buses and trolley coaches that reach every neighborhood. Most lines operate at least every 20 minutes. Many operate much more frequently, with heavily trafficked routes offering express or limited-stop service. Many lines operate at least until 1:00 a.m. Owl all-night service is available to all areas.

The historic F-Market Streetcar line provides frequent service along Market Street between the Upper Market / Castro area and Embarcadero (San Francisco Ferry Building), continuing to Pier 39 and Fisherman's Wharf.

San Francisco's three world famous cable car routes offer another alternative to reach the northeast section of town. The California Street route begins adjacent to the BART/Muni Metro Embarcadero Station and follows California Street west to Van Ness Ave. The other two routes begin at the Powell Street BART/Muni Metro Station, and connect downtown with Fisherman's Wharf.

**Caltrain** Operates Regional Rail Service between San Francisco and San Jose/Gilroy. SF Muni's N-Judah train connects the Caltrain Station with the BART/Muni Metro Embarcadero Station--two blocks from the Amtrak stop at the Ferry Building. Amtrak's new Peninsula bus route offers direct service between the Emeryville Amtrak Station and Millbrae Caltrain station, convenient for those connecting to or from Caltrain. Amtrak's San Jose station is served by Caltrain, and the Amtrak Gilroy bus stop is in front of the Caltrain station.

Passengers traveling between San Francisco or Peninsula points and Santa Cruz may transfer between Caltrain and the Amtrak bus at San Jose. Likewise, passengers traveling to or from Gilroy, Watsonville, Salinas, Monterey, Paso Robles, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, or intermediate points, may also transfer between Caltrain and the Amtrak bus at San Jose. Separate tickets are required for Caltrain and Amtrak.

Caltrain tickets may be purchased at staffed stations, from ticket vending machines, or on board trains (although a surcharge may apply if boarding at a staffed station).

### San Francisco International Airport and Peninsula Bus

Getting to San Francisco International Airport from stations along the Capitol Corridor is easy with Amtrak's Peninsula Bus. A Thruway bus connection meets Capitol Corridor trains at Emeryville and takes passengers directly to the Airport. At the airport, the buses pick up and drop off passengers at seven different locations on the lower (baggage claim) level. These stops are easily identified by the large blue pillars and "Scheduled Transit" signs.

**IMPORTANT:** When making an Amtrak to airline connection using this bus service, be sure to give yourself plenty of time. Most domestic airlines request at least one hour to check in. Traffic conditions on the Bay Bridge and Bayshore Freeway can cause unexpected delays to the bus, as can a late train arrival at Emeryville.

**At least 1-1/2 hours connecting time is suggested.**

In addition to the Airport, the bus also serves the Caltrain station in Millbrae, offering a convenient connection for those with destinations on the San Francisco Peninsula. Caltrain offers frequent Regional Rail service between Millbrae and stations along the Peninsula. See the Caltrain description at left.

**Reservations are required** on the Peninsula bus to or from the Airport or Millbrae. These can be made through your travel agent, at your local Amtrak station, or by calling Amtrak's toll-free reservation line at 1-800-USA-RAIL.

**Staffed Amtrak Stations** are shown in **UPPER CASE**. Passengers boarding at unstaffed stops or stations are advised to purchase tickets in advance from a travel agent or Amtrak. Passengers without tickets, boarding trains at unstaffed stations, may purchase tickets from the train conductor without penalty. Passengers without tickets boarding trains at staffed stations may be subject to a \$7 surcharge. Passengers without tickets, boarding buses at unstaffed stops, will either be sold a ticket by bus driver or carried to the next open ticket office to purchase tickets from their boarding point.

**Ticket Vending Machines** (TVMS). Passengers can purchase tickets for train travel with a major credit or debit card at ticket vending machines located at the following stations: Sacramento, Martinez, Emeryville, Ferry Buiding (San Francisco), Oakland-Jack London Square and Fremont/Centerville.
